



### To created this card:

You will need a piece of 5 1/2" x 8 1/2" Old Olive card stock folded in half; a 5 1/4" x 4" piece of Whisper White card stock; a piece of 2" x 3 7/8" Perfect Plum card stock; and a 2" x 3" piece of Whisper White card stock, a scrap piece of Silver Foil paper about 1 3/4" x 1/2"; a piece of 2" x 3" of acetate paper; scrap Whisper White card stock; and a piece of Silver Glitter paper.

- Cut the piece of 2" x 3 7/8" Perfect Plum into a banner and dry emboss it with the Sparkle Embossing Folder then adhere it to the Whisper White card stock about 1/2" from the left hand side.
- Using Memento Tuxedo Black ink stamp the greeting (in the upper right hand corner) using two separate stamps from the Endless Birthday Wishes set...the birthday stamp and the wishes stamp.
- Place the large jar die from the Everyday Jars Framelits over the "banner section" and run it through the Big Shot to cut out the jar shape. *(Be sure to leave yourself enough room from the edges to add the foam strips to create the shaker portion of the card.)*
- Stamp the jar image on the acetate using Black Stazon ink.
- Adhere the acetate piece to the back of the Whisper White card stock so the image shows through the jar opening. (This will allow you to determine where you want to stamp the dandelion images.)
- Using the larger dandelion stamp from Balloon Celebration stamp the image randomly in the lower right corner to make the wishes appear as they were being poured out of the jar. The inks are Perfect Plum and Old Olive.
- Again, using the larger dandelion stamp, stamp three images or more on the 2" x 3" Whisper White card stock. (This will be the back to the shaker)
- Once more using the larger dandelion stamp, stamp seven images on the scrap Whisper White card stock and fussy cut them out - this does not have to be exact.
- Using the heart die from the Everyday Jars Framelits die cut hearts from the glitter paper.
- Edge the backside of the jar image that is stamped on the acetate with a foam strip. (You will not use a full strip for this.)
- Fill the open shaker portion with the fussy cut dandelions and the hearts. You will need three hearts for the card front. (Make sure you have the shaker pieces facing the right way.)
- Remove the film from the foam strip to expose the sticky side.
- Adhere the 2" x 3" Whisper White card stock with the dandelion images facing up to enclose the shaker pieces.
- Adhere the 5 1/4" x 4" Whisper White card stock to the card base. (I used foam strips along the edges.)
- On a scrap piece of Silver Foil paper, using Black Stazon, stamp the jar lid.
- Using the lid die from Everyday Jars Framelits, die cut the lid and then attached it with adhesive over the jar mouth.
- Attached the remaining three hearts to the card.
